Erasmus+ students are not required to present a specific language certificate and do not need to pass a specific language level test.

#### Language courses:

Incoming students can attend Spanish Academic courses in our Language Institute (Ucoidiomas) in three levels: A1, B1 and B2. Everyone has its own characteristics of access (B1 and B2 with previous online test). These courses, are considered as subject and they has all features of any other University subjects, such as attending in classroom, works, study, examinations, etc.

#### H. Insurance

Erasmus+ students must present adequate medical coverage for their stay in Spain, in accordance with current regulations of their place of residence and / or the Spanish Consulate or Embassy where they apply for their visa.

In addition, it is compulsory to have travel and accident insurance before arrival at the University of Cordoba. Incoming students can obtain the same insurance coverage that the University of Cordoba offers its own students, which is private but has a special price (approximately EUR 19). More information at:

Other travel and accident insurance with equivalent coverage may also be accepted and must equally be presented.

It is also highly recommended for all EU citizens to obtain the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC blue card) before their arrival.

#### I. Admission process

1. - Institution must send a nomination/presentation letter\* with student data; full name, passport, studies and period of time of exchange, duly signed and sealed by the responsible person of his/her School.

(\*these steps (1 and 2) must be in parallel, one before another, it's not important which one is the first, but before send his/her admission letter we need to have both documents in our office)

2.- The student must upload his/her data on the online Application Form and send a copy of the report with his/her proposal of Learning Agreement, both documents can be found on this link:

(Please, review the information shown in this website because there are another important documents that must be brought with him/her)

3. - The proposal of subjects that the student includes on his/her Learning Agreement must be checked and accepted by the Coordinator of the School where the student is going to attend lessons in UCO.

It's very important to choose subjects from the "2° cuatrimestre (2nd term: from February to July) or 1° cuatrimestre (1st quarter: from September to February) " which are those subjects that are going to be given every quarter in UCO.

4. - Those students who intend to do internships in the area of Medicine / Nursing / Physiotherapy / Education, must provide, additionally, Certificate of Criminal / Sexual Offenses in their Country.

Once in our country, they will be guided for the delivery of a certificate of confidentiality in the Office of International Relations and assistance to our Government Subdelegation to be issued to those who have no history of such crimes in our country.

5. - Copy of insurance of health and accidents (with covering for full stay in our University)

6.- If the academic proposal is alright we will make his/her admission letter and will send it electronically signed to the student.

The student must keep every document needed on the process in order to let him/her show it in our office if needed.

We usually reply and finish our part of the process (mainly checking of academic proposals) in one or two days, so when the time of nomination starts, I recommend the student initiate his/her process in order to guarantee the best options taken into account that could have any inconvenience.

Our times to receive nominations/Application from Universities/students are:

### Fall semester and full academic year:

- .- Nomination (University) from 15<sup>th</sup> March to 15<sup>th</sup> April)
- .- Application (students) from 15<sup>th</sup> April (or after Nomination) till May 15<sup>th</sup>

# **Spring Semester**

- .- Nomination (University) from 15<sup>th</sup> September to 15<sup>th</sup> October)
- .- Application (students) from 15<sup>th</sup> October (or after Nomination) till November 15<sup>th</sup>
